- Concerns about a Student's Well-Being – emotional distress, self-harm, or unsafe situations

How to Report 🚨

- Tell a Trusted Adult – teacher, counselor, administrator, or staff member
- Use Anonymous Reporting Tools – Safe To Tell
- Call 911 in Emergencies – if there's an immediate threat to safety
